## **Disclosure of transfers of value to healthcare professionals and healthcare organisations**

Dear Disclosure Team,

Syner-Med (PP) Ltd. is currently not member of ABPI, however, voluntarily agreed to abide by ABPI Code of Practice in all aspects of commercial and non-commercial activities, particularly interactions with healthcare professionals (HCPs) and healthcare organisations (HCOs). Syner-Med follows the ABPI Code of Practice with regards to any payments (Sponsorships, Registration fee, honoraria etc.) made to HCPs and HCOs in accordance to Clause 1.4, 1.5, 1.10, 4.4 10, 20, 23, 24, 28 & 29.

### METHODOLOGY

Syner-Med has Policies and Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) in place in line with ABPI Code of Practice, e.g. Sponsorship/Grant Requests, Advisory Boards, Meetings and Hospitality and all such requests are processed and approved as per relevant policies and SOPs. Honoraria for consultancy work or Advisory Board meetings etc. are calculated on Fair Market Value (FMV) based on the HCP's role, seniority, time (excluding travel times), hourly/daily rates and industry average.

Syner-Med maintains a complete record of all sponsorship/grant requests and payment made to HCPs and HCOs.

In row 9 and 10 of the disclosure template, Syner-Med PP Ltd provided payment for advisory services in the fields of Urology and Women's Health and advice on clinical trial design. The total amount paid to 2 HCPs for 2024 disclosure was £47,150.00



Syner-Med has not made any payment to HCOs in 2024 for grants, sponsorships, advisor boards, meeting and hospitality or research and development.
