Methodological note for HCP/ORDM/HCO disclosure 2025

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1 Definitions

1.1 Recipients

EVER Pharma UK (EPUK) has made payment to the following types of recipients.

Healthcare Professional (HCP)

HCP's include members of the medical, dental, pharmacy and nursing professions and any other persons who, during their activities, may administer, prescribe, purchase, recommend or supply a medicine.

Healthcare Organisation (HCO)

HCO means either a healthcare, medical or scientific association or organisation such as a hospital, clinic, foundation, university or other teaching institution or learned society whose business address, place of incorporation or primary place of operation is in Europe or an organisation through which one or more HCPs or other relevant decision makers provide services.

1.2 Kind of ToVs

Categories disclosed against individual HCPs for ToV made in 2025.

- 1) Fees for service and consultancy and associated related expenses. These are agreed in the fee for service/consultancy contract with EPUK

EPUK pays fair market value fees for the provision of services provided by HCPs/ORDMs.

- 2) Associated expenses. These may include: travel expenses, accommodation rates (which may include dinner, bed and breakfast, or room only rates) and other associated expenses claimed by the service provider (e.g. parking, any additional appropriate subsistence).
- 3) Sponsorship of HCPs/ORDMs for attendance at meetings (including honorarium, registration fees and associated expenses in the form of travel and accommodation)

Categories disclosed against individual HCOs for ToV made in 2025.

- 1) Sponsorship agreements with HCOs to manage an event, such as part funded independent educational events. This also includes sponsorship involving catering costs and any other forms of funding (e.g., logistical costs) as part of a sponsorship package. These are disclosed as a ToV (sponsorship).
- 2) EPUK provides a nurse service as a package deal to HCOs, details can be found in section 2.11

2 Disclosure's Scope

2.1 Products concerned

EPUK provide Prescription Only Medicines (POMs)

2.2 Company concerned

All disclosures relate only to EPUK

2.3 Excluded ToVs

ToVs excluding from the scope of disclosure include:

- 1) Medical items and ancillaries that are provided to patient free of charge that are required for the administration of EPUK medicines are excluded from our disclosure.
- 2) ToVs which are part of the ordinary course of purchase and sale of medicinal products, such as rebates and price reductions.
- 3) Subsistence is not within the scope of the ABPI disclosure obligations and as such no costs associated purely with subsistence have been disclosed, unless included in a "day delegate rate" and EPUK have been unable to separate the subsistence cost from the room hire.

2.4 ToVs date

EPUK discloses to the ABPI all ToVs made between January 1st and December 31st of 2025.

2.5 Direct ToVs

Categories disclosed against individual HCPs for ToVs made in 2025.

- 1) Fees for service and consultancy and associated related expenses. These are agreed in the fee for service/consultancy contract with

EPUK pays fair market value fees for the provision of services provided by HCPs/ORDMs.

2.8 ToVs in case of partial attendances or cancellation and refund

EPUK did not have any ToVs relating to partial attendance or cancellation during 2025.

2.9 Cross-border activities

EPUK is part of the EVER Group and operates globally via affiliates and partners. Cross border payments are communicated internally and reconciled locally to ensure all relevant UK ToVs are included within this disclosure.

Any payments made in Euros have been converted to Pounds based on the Euro to Pound exchange rate at the time the payment was made.

In 2025, there were no cross-border activities in the disclosure.

2.10 R&D

EPUK did not have any ToVs relating to R&D in 2025

2.11 Voluntary disclosure

EPUK Nurse Service

EPUK provides a nurse service as part of the purchase price of its product (i.e. Package Deal), this service is provided by an external party.

The total cost of providing this service to the HCOs has been calculated using the total external party costs for the provision of nurses, divided by the number of HCOs where a Service Level Agreement was in place to deliver nurse support during 2025. Hence, this provides an average cost per HCO.

The cost is then disclosed against each HCO trust as a 'sponsorship agreement with HCOs/Third party organisations appointed by HCOs to manage an event' as this TOV cannot easily be disclosed elsewhere.

3 Specific considerations

3.1 Country unique identifier

EPUK did not use any commercial identifiers in the disclosure for 2025.

3.2 Self-incorporated HCP

EPUK did not make any payments to Health Professionals with their own Limited Company in 2025

3.3 Multi-year agreements

EPUK did not have any multiyear agreements in 2025 relating to ToV.

3.5 Quality Checks

Prior to data submission, quality checks confirming the data is accurate are carried out by EPUK. These include, but are not limited to

- Confirming data against internal databases e.g. CRM system and accounting systems
- Approval process for publication, including commercial team and UK General Manager
- Confirming contracts have been signed and parties have agreed to publication of ToV
- Confirming costs for provision on EPUK Nurse Service from external provider to ensure accurate allocation to HCO's
- Confirming Service Level Agreements to ensure accurate allocation of costs to HCOs

These checks have all been completed prior to publication.

4 Data protection legal basis

4.1 Consent collection

EPUK has used consent to publish individual HCP/ORDM information. This was collected as part of a contract signed by both parties.

The consent form is stored electronically on the HCPs record in a password protected CRM system, designed to manage, and record ToVs.

If an HCP provides consent to disclose ToVs associated with each activity against them, this will be disclosed against the individual.

If an HCP declines to provide consent to disclose, any ToVs made to that HCP will be disclosed within the aggregate.

There are no partial disclosures for individuals during 2025.
