Immedica UK Limited / Neurocrine UK Limited - Methodological Note for HCP/ORDM/HCO disclosure 2025

Data year: 2025

Year of publication: 2026

The company making this 2025 disclosure is known at the time of reporting in March 2026 as 'Immedica UK Limited'. Immedica UK Limited is a company registered in England and Wales. It changed its registered company name from Neurocrine UK Limited to Immedica UK Limited on 9 February 2026.

Throughout the data year 2025, the company now known as Immedica UK Limited was registered with the company name 'Neurocrine UK Limited', having previously changed its registered company name from Diurnal Limited to Neurocrine UK Limited on 21 October 2024. Throughout the data year 2025, Neurocrine UK Limited was part of the Neurocrine Biosciences group of companies, operating as a wholly owned subsidiary of Neurocrine Biosciences Inc. In January 2026, the parent company of the company now known as Immedica UK Limited was purchased by the Immedica Pharma group, after which the ultimate owner of the company now known as Immedica UK Limited is Immedica Pharma AB, a company registered in Sweden.

The disclosures for the data year 2025 made by the company now known as Immedica UK Limited will be reported in the company's previous name of 'Neurocrine UK Limited' as this was the name of the company for the duration of the data year 2025 and therefore the company name which the HCPs/ORDMs/HCOs subject of the disclosure would recognise.

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1. Definitions

1.1. Recipients

Payments made during 2025 to UK and European entities were reviewed, and direct and indirect transfers of value to recipients under the ABPI 2024 Code of Practice and EFPIA codes were identified, as categorized in the recipients definitions and Transfers of Value Categories below:

- a. **Healthcare Professional (HCP):** A member of the medical, dental, pharmacy or nursing professions or any other person who, during his/her professional activities, may prescribe, purchase, supply, recommend or administer a Medicinal Product and whose primary practice, principal professional address or place of incorporation is in Europe.
- b. **Other Relevant Decision Makers (ORDMs):** Includes recipients with an NHS role who could influence in any way the administration, consumption, prescription, purchase, recommendation, sale, supply or use of any medicine but who are not HCPs.
- c. **Healthcare Organization (HCO):** a healthcare, medical or scientific association or organization such as a hospital, clinic, foundation, university or other teaching institution or learned society whose business address, place of incorporation or primary place of operation is in Europe or through which one or more HCPs provide services

1.2. Kind of ToVs

A direct or indirect transfer of value, whether in cash, in kind or otherwise, in connection with the development or sale of medicines. A direct transfer of value is made directly by a company for the benefit of a recipient. Indirect transfers of value are those made on behalf of the company for the benefit of a Recipient, or those made through a Third Party and where Neurocrine UK Limited knows or can identify the Recipient that will benefit from the Transfer of Value.

2.9. Cross-border activities

Neurocrine UK Limited includes TOV to Recipients in the UK and other EFPIA countries. This includes all TOV made by Neurocrine UK Limited to Recipients in the European countries covered in the ABPI and EFPIA codes. Inclusion of Recipients in other EFPIA countries goes beyond the requirements of the ABPI code. This decision aligns with the disclosure methodology previously implemented by Neurocrine UK Limited in 2023 and 2024. During data year 2025 Neurocrine UK Limited is unable to disclose values separately for regions outside the UK because it lacked affiliates and presence in certain markets. Additionally, during data year 2025 Neurocrine UK Limited medicines were also marketed in other countries, for example the United States, Switzerland, Sweden, Denmark, Norway and Iceland by alliance partner pharmaceutical organisations who disclose ToVs as separate entities.

2.10. R&D

This disclosure includes ToVs to HCPs or HCOs related to the planning or conduct of:

Neurocrine UK Limited obtains the consent, as required, of each HCP to disclose their personal data primarily via data protection, privacy, and disclosure clauses in contracts. Neurocrine UK Limited will disclose the total value of the TOVs for those HCPs and ORDMs who have given consent for individual disclosure. For those who do not provide consent or where consent is withdrawn, their TOVs will be included in an aggregated total, as required by the ABPI Code.
