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1 Definitions

1.1 Recipients

[ABPI Definition - Health professional (HCP)] includes any member of the medical, dental, pharmacy or nursing profession and any other person who in the course of their professional activities may administer, prescribe, purchase, recommend or supply a medicine. In relation to the annual disclosure of transfers of value (Clause 28), the term also includes any employee of a pharmaceutical company whose primary occupation is that of a practising health professional.]

‘ABPI Definition - Healthcare organisation (HCO)’ means either a healthcare, medical or scientific association or organisation such as a hospital, clinic, foundation, university or other teaching institution or learned society whose business address, place of incorporation or primary place of operation is in Europe or an organisation through which one or more health professionals or other relevant decision makers provide services

ToVs for retired health professionals is N/A.

ToVs relating to deceased health professionals or other relevant decision makers is N/A.

ABPI Definition - ‘Medicine’ means any branded or unbranded medicine intended for use in humans which requires a marketing authorisation.

ABPI Definition - Transfer of value’ means a direct or indirect transfer of value, whether in cash, in-kind or otherwise, made, whether for promotional purposes or otherwise, in connection with the development or sale of medicines. An indirect transfer of value is one made on behalf of a company for the benefit of a recipient or through an intermediate and where the company knows or can identify the recipient that will benefit from the transfer of value

1.2 Kind of ToVs

like to provide goods or services to the benefit of the pharmaceutical company in return. Donations and grants to individuals are prohibited. In general, donations are physical items, services or benefits-in-kind which may be offered or requested. Grants are the provision of funds.

ABPI Definition - Contracted services are when HCPs, other relevant decision makers (ORDM) or their employers on their behalf, HCO, patient organisations (PO), individuals representing patient organisations, and members of the public, including patients and journalists, may be used as consultants and advisors, whether in groups or individually, for services such as speaking at and chairing meetings, involvement in medical/scientific studies, clinical trials or training services, writing articles and/or publications, participation at advisory board meetings, and participation in market research where such participation may involve remuneration and/or hospitality.

Contracted services fees and expenses – Fair Market Value was paid to UK individuals, organisations, etc. for contracted services such as chairing and speaking at meetings, assistance with training and participation in advisory boards, etc.

ABPI Definition - Sponsorship, including contributions to costs related to events/meetings paid to healthcare organisations or to organisations managing events on their behalf, which may include support of health professionals not known to the company via the healthcare organisation by way of registration fees, accommodation and travel, in accordance with Clause 10.12.]
