General summary

All values are in British Pounds Sterling

All HCPs and HCOs are UK based and therefore there are no implications regarding tax, currency nor cross border payments.

Donation, Grant & Sponsorship definitions:

Donation: A contribution given to an organisation or person.

Grant: An amount of money given to an organisation for a particular purpose.

Sponsorship: Financial support has been provided to an organisation

Payments to HCPs: Exclude VAT as they were not VAT registered

Payments to HCO: Exclude VAT

Calculation of FMV

When requesting the services of HCPs and HCOs Rosemont maintain a standard fair market value (FMV) methodology to ensure consistency. FMV compensation is driven by three factors; FMV rates, a robust tiering model and activity fees. We compensate travel based on hourly rate and number of hours HCP must travel to participate in an activity.

Contracts are compiled prior to any activity which clearly defines the arrangements and expected outputs of the engagements.

HCPs

Rosemont has selected HCPs to engage with, in accordance with their relevant expertise and capability to contribute meaningfully enabling Rosemont to answer legitimate business questions.

39 HCPs have been engaged with Rosemont Pharmaceuticals during 2019. Six individuals did not consent to disclosure and therefore appear in the aggregate section on the submission.

All fees are for work undertaken on our behalf.
